1. Approval item: Minutes from March 30, 2016 Meeting

Chairperson Meredith asked the committee members to review the minutes. A motion was made by Mr. Murray Wanner and seconded by Mr. Ed Poppe to approve the minutes. Minutes approved with no objections.

2. Bicycle Facilities Study

The next agenda item was an update on the Bicycle Facilities Study. Mr. Mike Skaggs provided a brief overview of the draft Bicycle Facilities Plan. The committee discussed several issues including ... the inclusion of signage in chapter 3, the

proper use of sharrows, updating functional classification and data on local road and streets, costs of improvements, justification of recommendations, responsibility to plan for routes that are the safest possible for bicyclists, and specific routes in and around Fort Knox including Bullion Boulevard and Wilson Road. The next steps in the process are to update the plan based on comments and recommendations from TAC members, and to update maps to reflect the different types of recommendations.

3. District 4 Project Update

- Ring Road Extension – Right-of-Way on hold, except relocations will be purchased so those residents are not left waiting.
- Cardinal Drive – KYTC to purchase the ROW
- St. John Road Widening – preliminary design complete, alignment selected – no funding in the approved Highway Plan
- KY 251 – funding available to complete up to KY 434
- KY 1600 HSIP Project – Integrated Engineering selected – plan to be complete soon
- I-65 HSIP Project – bottom of Muldraugh Hill - resurfacing
- I-65 – complete up to Munfordville – section up to Sonora complete by spring of 2017 – to E'town 2018
- US 31W at KY 84 in Sonora – looking at various options including a 4-way stop and roundabout
- KY 313 – Last 2 sections under construction – US 60 to Buck Grove to open next month – last section to KY 1628 complete by summer 2017
- KY 79 – Design or Right-of-Way on hold – other two sections-recent public meeting, working on design
