1. Approval item: Minutes from June 16, 2016 Meeting

Chairperson Meredith asked the committee members to review the minutes. Mr. Murray Wanner pointed out a typo on page 2 of the minutes, 1628 should be 1638. Mr. Ed Poppe made a motion to approve the minutes as amended, the motion was given a second by Mr. Wanner. The minutes were approved with no objections.

2. Bicycle Facilities Study

The next agenda item was an update on the Bicycle Facilities Study. Mr. Mike Skaggs provided an update on the draft Bicycle Facilities Plan. Below are the changes that have been made to the document since the previous review by the TAC ...

- Air Quality paragraph added to Chapter 1
- Complete Street paragraph added to Chapter 3
- Narrative updated in Chapter 3 to include information about the usage of signage and sharrows
- Chapter 4 – Recommendations – updated recommendation as signage and/or sharrows, data filled in as complete as possible, possible Shared Use Path along the north side of Ring Road from Veterans Way to US 62 east.
- Maps updated to show different colors for various types of recommendations
- Chapter 5 – includes costs for signage and sharrows

The next steps include taking local photos for the plan and clean up and finalize based on TAC comments.

The committee made the following recommendations ... including a paragraph on bike racks; in Chapter 5 under Road Resurfacing, remove signal timing and add sharrows; include KYTC in the Chapter 2 paragraph under Technical Advisory Committee; move the Complete Streets paragraph under Bicycle Facility Network in Chapter 3; and add Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD) in the Signage section Bicycle Facility Network in Chapter 3.

3. District 4 Project Update

- Interviews for new Chief District Engineer held last week
- Official KYTC Highway Plan is now on KYTC website
- Ring Road Extension – Right-of-Way – only buying relocations
- Cardinal Drive – buying R-O-W (preliminary appraisals)
- St. John Road Widening – only enough funding for final design, project is not in KYTC Highway Plan
- KY 251 – buying R-O-W – 2017
- US 62 – bridge near Stephensburg – will be let next March
- KY 361 at Deckard School Road – set for Nov. letting but aiming for Oct.

- HSIP Projects – KY 1600, KY 313/US 31W, KY 447/US 31W, KY 1815/US 31W, KY 1646/Elm Road
- I-65 – complete up to Munfordville – section up to Sonora complete by spring of 2017 – to E'town fall 2018
- KY 313 – Last 2 sections under construction – US 60 to Buck Grove complete – last section to KY 1638 complete by summer 2017
- KY 79 – Right-of-Way on hold for first section – other two sections - June public meeting, working on design

4. Public Comments – No public comments were made.

5. Other Business – Mr. Vince Carman mentioned a meeting scheduled for August 15 at 6:00 pm to discuss the trail master plan. Mr. Russell Clark from the National Park Service present at the meeting.
