Chairman Harry Berry called the meeting to order at approximately 10:50 a.m.

A quorum was not present at this meeting.

The first agenda item was approval of the minutes from the April 30, 2015 meeting of the Policy Committee. There were no objections to the minutes. Without a quorum, the minutes from this meeting (May 28) will be included as an addendum to the April 30 meeting to be approved at the next meeting.

The second agenda item was a review of the Unscheduled Needs List (UNL) priorities as set by the MPO Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) at their meeting on May 18. The Policy Committee recommended moving the Ring Road (KY 3005) project up to #14 from #24 and adjust all other projects down one spot. They also recommended moving the Bluegrass Parkway Ramps project up to #26 from #35. The priorities will be sent to all committee members, via email, for a final vote of approval.

The third agenda item was a project update from Mrs. Patty Dunaway, District 4 Chief Highway Engineer, on the following projects in the MPO area:

**Meade County**

- KY 79

- KY 313
- KY 710 – HSIP Project

**Hardin County**

- Interstate 65 – could be 21-31 miles under construction at the same time
- KY 1357 (St. John Road)
- KY 251/KY 434 – possibly design/build
- US 31W – HSIP Project – should start anytime
- Larue County Connection to I-65 – meeting June 30

Next, Chairman Berry called for public comments. No comments from the public were brought forward.

There was no other business brought before the committee.
