Call to Order: 10:10 am

1. Approval item: Minutes from August 1, 2017 Meeting

Chairperson Meredith asked the committee members to review the minutes. Mr. Barry House made a motion to approve the minutes, the motion was given a second by Mr. Joe Redmon. The minutes were approved with no objections.

2. Pavement, Bridge, and System Performance & Transit Asset Management Performance Targets

The committee was provided with information related to Pavement, Bridge, and System Performance Targets as set by the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet (KYTC). Mr. Mike Skaggs informed the committee that the MPO has two options: support the performance targets set by KYTC or develop its own targets. The recommendation is to support the KYTC performance targets. Following review and discussion, Mr. Murray Wanner made a motion to recommend to the Policy Committee to support the performance targets set by KYTC. Mr. Damon Gooch seconded the motion. Motion carried.

The committee also reviewed Transit Asset Management (TAM) targets that were set by the Transit Authority of Central Kentucky (TACK). According to federal law, the MPO must set its

own targets for Transit Asset Management. Since the MPO really doesn't have control over TACK and its vehicles, Mr. Skaggs recommended that the MPO adopt the same targets that were set by TACK. Mr. Joe Redmon made a motion to recommend to the Policy Committee the adoption of the Transit Asset Management performance targets as presented. Mr. Murray Wanner seconded the motion. Motion carried.

3. MPO Pedestrian Survey

Mr. Mike Skaggs presented the committee with the pedestrian survey results that had been received to date. The plan is for the survey to stay open until the end of October. The survey results indicate there is an interest in having more pedestrian facilities that are accessible and convenient. The survey also shows that the majority of people are utilizing pedestrian facilities for recreation and enjoyment rather than specifically for transportation purposes. There are several comments related to the safety of the pedestrian facilities and also the desire to have a more connected system, including connections to parks and trails. Following the survey, the next steps will include a review of the existing conditions and the development of recommendations to improve the pedestrian network.

6. Public Comments – No public comments were made.

7. Other Business

Mr. Barry House asked about the Traffic Model data discussion from the August 1 TAC meeting. Information is needed from local planning agencies such as future land use or zoning maps.
