1. Approval item: Minutes from October 3, 2017 Meeting

Chairperson Meredith asked the committee members to review the minutes. Mr. Barry House made a motion to approve the minutes, the motion was given a second by Mr. Chris Mayhew. The minutes were approved with no objections.

2. MPO Pedestrian Plan

The committee was provided a copy of the final survey results, the proposed vision and goals for the plan, and a copy of potential recommendation. Mr. Mike Skaggs provided a summary of the survey results including the written comments received. The comments provided numerous ideas for locations that need pedestrian improvements. There was considerable discussion on the proposed improvements and Mr. Skaggs informed the committee that the LTADD GIS Specialist would be working to map all locations recommended for improvement. He asked the

committee members to please review the recommendations and provide feedback and any additions or deletions to the list. The committee also review the proposed vision and goals for the plan. The vision and goals were developed based on feedback received from the survey. The goal is to have a draft plan ready for review in late winter or early spring.

3. TIP Amendment #1

The following TIP Amendment was presented to the TAC for review and consideration for recommendation to the Policy Committee for final approval.

Route: KY 1357 (St. John Road)

Project Type: Safety, Geometrics, Drainage and Maintenance Improvements

Length: 1.678 miles

Phases: Right-of-Way, Utilities

Type of Funding: STP

Responsible Agency: Kentucky Transportation Cabinet, District 4

Amount: \$5,500,000

Project Description: Improve Safety, Geometrics, Drainage, and Maintenance Issues along KY 1357 (St. John Road) from US 31W Bypass to KY 3005 (Ring Road) in Elizabethtown.

This amendment was advertised in The News Enterprise and the public review and comment period ran from November 9 through November 27. No public comments were received. Mr. Adam King made a motion to approve and recommend to the Policy Committee for final approval. The motion was seconded by Mr. Murray Wanner. Motion carried.
