**1. Approval item: Minutes from December 5, 2018 Meeting**

Chairperson Meredith asked the committee members to review the minutes. Mr. Murray Wanner made a motion to approve the minutes, the motion was given a second by Mr. Chris Mayhew. The minutes were approved with no objections.

**2. Strategic Highway Investment Formula for Tomorrow (SHIFT) 2020**

Mr. Mike Skaggs gave the committee a brief refresher on the SHIFT process. Then, then committee discussed projects to sponsor for the SHIFT 2020 prioritization cycle. The MPO is allotted 12 sponsorships for the SHIFT 2020 process. The committee was provided with a spreadsheet detailing all projects within the MPO planning area. The projects sponsored in 2017 were highlighted for the committee to give consideration of which projects it may want to consider sponsoring again for this cycle. Mr. Skaggs provided the technical scores for each of those projects from 2017. The committee discussed several projects including: Ring Road (KY 3005) extension over to I-65 and US 31W; New Glendale Road extension from US 31W to

Commerce Drive; and US 62 from Upper Colesburg Road to Stovall Road. After considerable discussion the committee decided to recommend to the Policy Committee sponsoring the following 12 projects. Mr. Adam King made a motion proposing the recommended projects, seconded by Mr. Chris Mayhew. Motion carried.

### 3. MPO Pedestrian Plan

Mr. Skaggs informed the committee that the draft Pedestrian Plan is currently in the works. The committee reviewed the proposed recommendations provided. Mr. Skaggs asked the committee to thoroughly review the recommendations for their particular jurisdiction and provide feedback before the draft plan is finalized. Mrs. Vicki Meredith requested that committee members provide feedback by February 19. The next steps in the process include finalizing the draft for review by the MPO TAC and making a recommendation for final approval by the MPO Policy Committee at their April meeting.

### 4. 2019 Safety Performance Targets

The Safety Performance Targets for 2019 have been set by KYTC. Each year the MPO has the option to either support the targets set by KYTC or adopt its own. Mr. Skaggs provided the committee with a copy of KYTC's 2019 Safety Targets and recommended that the MPO vote to support those targets. Mr. Adam King made a motion to recommend to the MPO Policy

Committee to support the 2019 Safety Targets set by KYTC, the motion was seconded by Mr. Murray Wanner. Motion carried.
