3. Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP) 2045

Mr. Skaggs informed the committee that the MPO staff is in the very beginning stages of updating the MPO's Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP). The current MTP expires in January 2020. A proposed timeline and schedule were provided to the committee along with the current goals and objectives for committee review and discussion. Mr. Skaggs said the plan for public involvement is to share information through the MPO website and social media and press releases to local media. A public meeting will be held after the draft MTP is developed. This agenda item was for information and committee discussion only. No action was required by the committee.

4. SHIFT 2020 Sponsored Projects

The committee was provided with a spreadsheet detailing all projects that have been sponsored by the MPO and District 4. There is a total of 22 projects in the MPO planning area have been sponsored. The next step is the KYTC technical scoring process. The MPO will received the scored projects in mid-June, then the MPO will be responsible for providing local "boost" points to projects to enhance the scores of the projects that are most important to the MPO.
