The Radcliff/Elizabethtown MPO Policy Committee met on Thursday, April 11, 2019 at 10:00 a.m. in the boardroom at Lincoln Trail ADD. Those in attendance were:

Chairman Harry Berry called the meeting to order at 10:15 a.m.

The first agenda item was consideration of the minutes from the January 10, 2019 with an addendum of the minutes from the March 7 MPO Policy Committee meeting. Mayor Ronnie Joyner made a motion to approve the minutes, seconded by Judge Berry. Motion carried.

The second agenda item was a presentation of the FY 2020 Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP). Mr. Mike Skaggs provided a summary of the FY 2020 UPWP including the Establishment of the MPO, Organization of the MPO, The Metropolitan Transportation Planning Process, and all of the work elements included in the Work Program portion of the UPWP. Following discussion, Mayor Jeff Gregory made a motion to approve the FY 2020 UPWP. The motion was seconded by Mayor Ronnie Joyner. Motion carried.

The third agenda item was approval of the MPO Pedestrian Plan. Mr. Skaggs provided a detailed overview of the Pedestrian Plan. The plan includes the Vision and Goals and Objectives for the plan, the Plan Development Process, Recommendations, Implementation, Survey Results, and Funding Options. Mayor Ronnie Joyner made a

motion to approve the Pedestrian Plan, seconded by Mayor Jeff Gregory, motion carried.

The next agenda item was approval of the Safety Performance Measure Targets for 2019. The MPO Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) voted to recommend that the MPO concur with and support the safety targets established by KYTC. The Policy Committee concurred with this recommendation and Mr. Paul Sanders made a motion to approve the 2019 Safety Performance Targets. Mayor Ronnie Joyner seconded the motion. Motion carried.

The fifth agenda item was information and discussion related to the update of the MPO's Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP). Mr. Skaggs provided the committee with a proposed timeline for the MTP update and informed the committee that the demographic data, land use & environmental data, and transportation-related data over the next few months. The MPO will also be reviewing the current list of highway projects and seeking the addition of new projects. The MTP process will take place throughout the remainder of calendar year 2019 with the updated plan to be approved in January of 2020.

Next, District 4 provided updates on local projects. See the attachment titled, *Project Updates*.

Next, Chairman Berry called for public comments. No comments from the public were received.

Chairman Berry then asked if there was any Other Business that needed to be discussed. No other business was brought forward.

With no other business to come before the committee, the meeting adjourned at approximately 10:55 a.m.
