The second agenda item was an update on the 2045 Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP). Mr. Mike Skaggs gave a presentation on the draft 2045 Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP). Each committee member was also provided with a copy of the draft MTP. The presentation covered each chapter of the MTP with more detail focused on Chapter 7, which includes all project recommendations. Following discussion and notation of a few minor changes requested by the committee, Mayor Jeff Gregory made a motion to approve the MTP for public review and comment. The motion was seconded by Judge Gerry Lynn. Motion carried. Mr. Skaggs noted that following public review, the draft MTP will be brought back to the committees for final review and approval.
