Call to Order: 10:05 am

1. Approval item: Minutes from October 29, 2019 Meeting

Chairperson Meredith asked the committee members to review the minutes. A couple of minor corrections were requested by the committee. Mr. Murray Wanner made a motion to approve the minutes with the corrections, the motion was seconded by Mr. Adam King. Motion carried.

2. Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP) 2045

The next agenda item was a final review of the 2045 Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP). Mr. Mike Skaggs provided an update on the MTP since the previous meeting. The MTP was open for public review and comment from November 4 through December 4. No comments were received from the public. However, a few comments were received from FHWA and those comments were addressed. The main changes

were to Tables 1 and 2 from Chapter 7. Table 1 was restructured to ensure that all project phases have a cost attached to them. Table 2 was adjusted to show a 5% per year Year of Expenditure Cost escalation for the right-of-way phase. All other phases are 4% per year. All other comments were very minor and included cleaning up typos and a couple of name changes. The committee reviewed the tables and requested a couple of minor changes to Table 2. Following review and discussion, Mr. Adam King made a motion to recommend final approval, with the requested changes, of the MTP to the Policy Committee. The motion was seconded by Mr. Murray Wanner. Motion carried.

3. FY 2020 Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP) Amendment

The third agenda item was an amendment to the FY 2020 UPWP to include the East Elizabethtown Transportation Connectivity Study. Mr. Skaggs informed the committee that an amendment of the UPWP was necessary to include the study so the MPO could issue the Request for Proposals (RFP) as soon as possible after the first of the year. The committee received a packet that included: Scope of Work for the study, Study Area Map, UPWP work element page being amended, and the UPWP Budget Table. The study cost will be \$250,000 with the local match being provided by KYTC through toll credits. The study will be contracted to a consultant and a selection committee will be designated. Following discussion, Mr. Adam King made a motion to recommend approval of the UPWP amendment to the Policy Committee, the motion was seconded by Mr. Jim Shaw. Motion carried.

4. 2020 Safety Performance Targets

KYTC recently developed their Safety Performance Targets for 2020. As in the past, Mr. Skaggs recommended that the MPO support the targets set by KYTC rather than going through the process of setting its own targets. The KYTC targets are outlined in the table below:
