The Radcliff/Elizabethtown MPO Policy Committee met on Thursday, January 9, 2020 at 10:00 a.m. in the boardroom at Lincoln Trail ADD. Those in attendance were:

Chairman Harry Berry called the meeting to order at 10:05 a.m.

The first agenda item was consideration of the minutes from the October 31, 2019. Judge Gerry Lynn made a motion to approve the minutes, seconded by Mayor Ronnie Joyner. Motion carried.

The second agenda item was the final review of the 2045 Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP). Mr. Mike Skaggs gave a brief overview of the 2045 MTP. The MPO Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) has guided the process of developing the MTP over the past 9-10 months, meeting almost monthly to review and provide guidance. The MTP has also gone through thorough review by both KYTC and FHWA and the public review and comment period ran from November 4 through December 4. The TAC had their final review on December 4 and voted to make a recommendation of approval to the Policy Committee. Following discussion, Mayor Joyner made a motion to approve the 2045 MTP, the motion was seconded by Judge Berry, motion carried.

The third agenda item was an amendment to the FY 2020 Unified Planning Work Program to include the East Elizabethtown Transportation Connectivity Study in the current work program. Mr. Skaggs gave an overview of the study and informed the committee that the cost will be \$250,000 with the local match being provided through

toll credits. Following discussion, Judge Lynn made a motion to approve the UPWP amendment, seconded by Mayor Joyner, motion carried.

The fourth agenda item was TIP Amendment #2 to the 2018-2022 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). The amendment was completed for the cost increase to the US 62 Bridge Replacement project at the Hardin/Nelson County Line. The cost increased from \$3.3 million to \$4,815,000. Judge Berry made a motion to approve the amendment, seconded by Mayor Joyner, motion carried.

The fifth agenda item was the Safety Performance Targets for 2020. KYTC recently set their targets for this year and the MPO is required to either set their own targets or support the KYTC targets. The recommendation from the Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) is to, once again, support the 2020 KYTC Safety Performance Targets. Judge Lynn made a motion to approve, seconded by Mayor Joyner, motion carried.
