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## RADCLIFF-ELIZABETHTOWN METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (TIP) FY 2018-2022 ADMINISTRATION MODIFICATION #1

## ACTION:

The Radcliff/Elizabethtown Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) hereby modifies the FY 2018-2022 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) to reflect the following change:

**18-044** – Hardin –Mill and intermediate asphalt overlay on the Western Kentucky Parkway (9001) from 0.059 miles northeast of Rhudes Creek Bridge (MP 130.948), extending northeast ending 0.584 miles southwest of US 31 overpass (MP 130.100) in Hardin County – <u>Increase in funding from \$2,500,000 to \$7,350,000</u> – National Highway Performance Program (NHPP).

Pavement Resurfacing, Restoration, and Rehabilitation projects are classified as Grouped Projects in the TIP; therefore a formal amendment is not necessary.

Funding has been approved or identified for these projects; therefore a new fiscal constraint analysis by the MPO is not necessary.
