FY: 2019, 2020

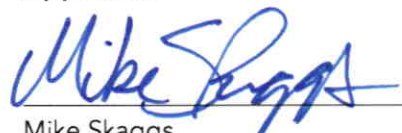

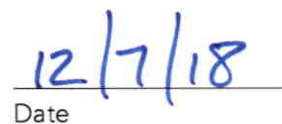
