### 1. Approval item: Minutes from October 14, 2020 Meeting

Mr. Charlie Allen made a motion to approve the minutes. The motion was seconded by Mr. Barry House. Motion carried.

# 2. Glendale Area Transportation Study Update

The second agenda item was an update on the Glendale Area Transportation Study update. The goal is to update the original 2008 study to ensure we are addressing the needs of the area as they exist in 2021. The aim is to provide for the needs of the mega site while, at the same time, protecting the historic community of Glendale. Mr. John David May led this study and has identified and consulted with stakeholders throughout the study process. The study provides updated existing conditions data, a review of development in the area, update of all maps for the study, and a transportation plan that details short, medium-, and long-range improvement options. Following review and discussion, Mr. Murray Wanner made a motion to recommend final approval to

the MPO Policy Committee. The motion was seconded by Mr. Murray Wanner. Motion carried.

# 3. Draft FY 2022 Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP)

Mr. Mike Skaggs gave the committee an update on the Draft FY 2022 Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP). The budget and local match for FY 2022 will be exactly the same as the current fiscal year. The major tasks for FY 2022 will be the development of a new Transportation Improvement Program, completion of the SHIFT 2022 process, Performance Measure Targets, and Employment-Based Traffic Patterns. The draft work program is due to KYTC and FHWA by the end of February. The committee specifically discussed the section related to election of officers and requested changes to elect officers on a bi-annual basis with a two-year term for both. Mr. Skaggs said he would research the issue and make some changes to reflect the committee's wishes.

# 4. SHIFT 2022

The fourth agenda item was an update on the schedule and process for the Strategic Highway Investment Formula for Tomorrow (SHIFT) 2022 prioritization process. The scheduled is as follows:

- Now March 12 Addition of New Projects to the KYTC CHAF Database
- March 1 May 14 Sponsorship of Projects
- May 3 June 25 KYTC Data Verification Process
- June 28 July 16 Statewide Prioritization for Projects on the National Highway System
- July 19 Sept. 14 Regional Prioritization
- Sept. 15 Oct. 8 Regional Project Selection
- Oct. 11 Dec. 27 Development of the Draft Highway Plan

### 5. TACK Safety Performance Targets

The MPO has coordinate with the Transit Authority of Central Kentucky (TACK) to establish Transit Safety Targets. TACK is required to have an Agency Safety Plan that establishes these targets. Then, the MPO is required to coordinate with and support the targets. TACK has set a goal to reduce all incidents by 10% and to keep fatalities and serious injuries at zero (0). Mr. Adam King made a motion to recommend approval of the MPO's support to the MPO Policy Committee. The motion was seconded by Mr. Murray Wanner. Motion carried.

# 6. TAC Committee Chairperson/Vice-Chairperson

With the retirement of Vicki Meredith, the TAC will need to elect a new committee chairperson and vice-chairperson. Mr. Murray Wanner nominated Mr. Jim Shaw to be the chair and Mr. Adam King to be the vice-chair. Mr. Charlie Allen made a motion to approve the nominations, seconded by Mr. Wanner, motion carried.
