**1. Approval item: Minutes from September 8, 2021 Meeting**

Mr. Barry House made a motion to approve the minutes. The motion was seconded by Mr. Adam King. Motion carried.

**2. 2022 Safety Performance Targets**

Mr. Mike Skaggs provided a brief overview of the 2022 Safety Performance Measures provided by KYTC. The targets are set as follows:

- Number of Fatalities – 752
- Number of Serious Injuries – 2,568
- Fatality Rate – 1.535
- Serious Injury Rate – 5.241
- Total Number of Non-Motorized Fatalities and Serious Injuries – 299

The MPO's proposal is to support the KYTC targets. Mr. Murray Wanner made a motion to recommend approval to the Policy Committee. The motion was seconded by Mr. Adam King. Motion carried.

**3. Draft FY 2023 Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP)**

Mr. Skaggs opened a discussion on the draft FY 2023 UPWP. He informed the committee that the draft document is due by the end of February 2022. With several

major projects completed over the past couple of years, Mr. Skaggs asked the committee to consider what new tasks the MPO should include in the UPWP. He also asked if there are any special studies or previous studies that the MPO should submit for potential discretionary funding. The committee discussed the potential to revisit and provide more details on the projects identified in the Glendale Area Transportation Study. Several projects were discussed including the I-65 interchange at Glendale, KY 1136 on the south side of the mega site, KY 84, KY 1136 (New Glendale Road). Mr. Skaggs said he would explore this option further.

Other options mentioned include Bike/Ped (Complete Streets), Federal Lands Management Area, and Census Data updates with the new 2020 Census data being released.

The draft UPWP will be finalized and presented to both MPO committee early in 2022.

- (4-8801.00) KY 1357 widening – WMB – Moving Utilities – July 2022 Letting (If funded in 2022 SYP)
