1. Approval item: Minutes from December 1, 2021 Meeting

2. Draft FY 2023 Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP)

Mr. Mike Skaggs gave a summary of the draft FY 2023 UPWP including the bylaws for both the Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) and Policy Committee and all work elements. He explained that many of the major work tasks come from the Planning Emphasis Areas (PEAs) provided by FHWA. Some of the major tasks included the FY 2023 UPWP include:

- Updating the Planning MOA between the MPO, TACK, and KYTC
- Review of Strategic Highway Network (STAHNET) maps and potential improvements

- Strategic Highway Investment Formula for Tomorrow (SHIFT) Prioritization Process
- Identify/Update Projects in KYTC’s Continuous Highway Analysis Framework (CHAF)
- MTP Amendment to include a System Performance Report
- Planning & Environmental Linkages
- Safety Analysis for Hardin & Meade County Roads
- Equity/Justice in Transportation Planning (GIS Mapping)
- Data in Transportation Planning – Safety, Freight, Bike/Ped Planning, Equity Analysis, Performance Management, Travel Time Reliability, Connected & Autonomous Vehicles, Mobility Services, etc.
- Revised Urbanized Area Boundary based on 2020 Census Data
- Update Functional Classification Maps based on Revised UA Boundary
- Complete Streets Data Collection – Miles of Sidewalks, Bike Lanes, Transit Stops, Freight Deliveries, etc.
- Complete Streets Implementation
- Assist, as necessary, with the Statewide Complete Streets Policy
- Federal Land Management Agency (FMLA) Coordination
