1. Approval item: Minutes from February 2, 2022 Meeting

Mr. Murray Wanner made a motion to approve the minutes. The motion was seconded by Mr. Adam King. Motion carried.

2. Safe Streets for All (SS4A)

Mr. Mike Skaggs gave a summary of the Safe Streets for All (SS4A) program and application process. The SS4A program is open to all MPOs, ADDs, cities, and counties. The grant opportunity was discussed with the MPO Policy Committee at their July meeting. Their preference is for us to apply for the entire ADD. If funded, the process will include the development of Safety Action Plans for all eight (8) LTADD counties. The SAPs will include a crash analysis and identification of strategic safety improvements to address safety issues on local roadways. The minimum grant amount is \$200,000 with a 20% local match. KYTC has agreed to provide the match for all ADDs that apply for this funding. The application deadline is September 15.

This is for information sharing only and did not require a motion.

3. Carbon Reduction Program

Mr. Skaggs informed the committee that the MPO has been designated \$236,605 through the Carbon Reduction Program. The MPO can choose a project or projects that fall under a list of eligible projects for this program. This has also been discussed with the Policy Committee but no decision has been made at this point on how to spend this funding. The

committee discussed a couple of options including assisting with projects such as the US 31W improvements or possibly public transportation. A decision was not made and options will continue to be explored.

4. Glendale Area Projects Update

Mr. Tom Springer with Qk4 provided an update on Glendale area projects. He discussed the KY 222 – Planning Study including the study area, future traffic assumptions, and potential improvement concepts. The study will continue and they hope to have proposed improvements announced in early 2023. He also discussed the KY 1136 Gilead Church Road improvements and the Ring Road (KY 3005) extension to I-65 and US 31W and ultimately over to the Lincoln Parkway.
