**1. Approval item: Minutes from April 18, 2023 Meeting**

Mr. Joe Reverman made a motion to approve the minutes. The motion was seconded by Mr. Adam King. Motion carried.

**2. Public Transportation Study RFP**

Mr. Mike Skaggs provided a summary of the Request for Proposals (RFP) for the Public Transportation Study. The RFP includes a project description, schedule milestones, evaluation factors, selection committee members, DBE requirement, special instructions, project scope, prequalification requirements, and submission requirements. Mr. Skaggs mentioned that he is still checking with KYTC concerning the DBE requirement. There were no suggested changes. Mr. Skaggs said the RFP will be advertised following Policy Committee approval at their meeting on July 13.

**3. Carbon Reduction Program**

Mr. Skaggs informed the committee that the MPO has been designated \$477,943 over FY 2022 and 2023. Any project request must support the reduction of emissions. The eligible project types include: safety, transit flex, truck parking, bike/ped, charging infrastructure, rural internet connectivity, and transportation alternatives. The committee discussed truck parking in the Glendale area. Mr. Skaggs said that no decision had to be made today but sometime in the future the MPO will need to determine how it plans to spend this funding. More allocations will be forthcoming. This program has been set up for 5 years.

**4. Election of TAC Officers**

Chairman Shaw called for nominations for Chairman. Mr. Joe Reverman nominated Adam King for Chairman and made a motion for approval. The motion was seconded by Mr. Charlie Allen. Motion carried.

Then, Chairman Shaw called for nominations for Vice-Chairman. Mr. Adam King nominated Mr. Joe Reverman for Vice-Chairman and made a motion for approval. The motion was seconded by Mr. Charlie Allen. Motion carried.

Mr. Kevin Blain provided updates on the US 62 and Glendale studies that are currently being conducted in the MPO planning area. Both studies are expected to be finalized soon and provide recommended improvements for both areas.
