**2. Public Transportation Study Kick-Off (Mrs. Patty Dunaway, Michael Baker International)**

Patty Dunaway and Emily Webb, both with Michael Baker International (MBI) attended the meeting to provide the committee with an update on the Public Transportation Study. This meeting served as the kick-off meeting for the study. Mrs. Dunaway provided a review of the scope of work and the current status of the study. MBI is currently in the data collection phase and will be putting together an existing conditions report. The next steps in the study process will include the development of a story map website, public survey, and stakeholder and local officials interviews.

### 3. Carbon Reduction Program

Mr. Mike Skaggs provided the committee with an overview of the Carbon Reduction Program and potential eligible project categories. The MPO currently has \$477,943 allocated for projects under the Carbon Reduction Program. Mr. Skaggs asked the committee to consider projects and submit any proposals for potential funding. He also mentioned that more funding for this program will be forthcoming. It is currently a 5 year program.
