1. Approval item: Minutes from August 22, 2024 Meeting

2. Public Transportation Study Update (Jake Zimmerer)

Mr. Jake Zimmerer presented the most recently deliverables provided by the consultant for the public transportation study. Mr. Zimmerer answered questions related to the proposed routes as well as where potential funding would come from. Georgetown was mentioned as a potentially similar model that could be replicated.

3. 2050 Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP) (Mr. Jake Zimmerer, Information and Discussion)

Mr. Jake Zimmerer provided the committee with the list of scored CHAF projects for the MTP update. Committee members engaged in a discussion regarding the scores and proposed adjusting several of them. The scores were recalculated and the new project priority order was created.

The next step of the MTP process involves a review of the document from various agencies and then a public review period.
