1. Approval item: Minutes from December 4th, 2024 Meeting

2. FY26 UPWP Review (Mr. Jake Zimmerer/Committee Members)

Mr. Jake Zimmerer presented a rough draft copy of the FY26 UPWP for the upcoming fiscal year. The committee was asked to provide feedback on the changes that were made from previous years and recommend any additions they felt should be added. Note was made of a few minor edits to various aspects of the UPWP.

3. SHIFT Schedule Update (Mr. Jake Zimmerer, Information and Discussion)

Mr. Jake Zimmerer gave a brief presentation on the upcoming 2025 SHIFT schedule and the number of boosts/sponsorships that would be available to the MPO. The committee discussed the schedule and decided that it would be best to move the upcoming meeting

date up to March 26th to avoid spring break so that as many committee members as possible could be in attendance to discuss the sponsorship of road projects.

4. TIP Update Schedule Review (Mr. Jake Zimmerer, Information and Discussion)

Mr. Jake Zimmerer provided the committee with a schedule for updating the MPO's Transportation Improvement Plan for the upcoming cycle. The current TIP is set to expire in September 2025. The schedule put forth allowed for approval of the updated TIP in early September before the deadline.
